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### Letter from the Executive Director

A s you read through our 2015-2016 🔼 annual report. I hope you will join me in celebrating many successes over the past year. For the first time in our organization's history, we distributed nearly 10 million pounds of food! And over two million pounds of that was fresh, highly nutritious produce. We had 2,350 volunteers who donated enough service for the equivalent of nearly 14 full-time employees – nearly doubling the Channel One workforce! In December we passed our AIB Food Safey audit, adhering to some of the strictest food safety practices in the nation. And we received our certification as a Service Enterprise Initiative, recognizing Channel One's commitment to fundamentally leveraging volunteers across our organization. Our list of accomplishments is long, and I am grateful to our staff, volunteers, and member agency partners who made these successes possible over the past year. But our hunger relief efforts certainly do not end here.

The future is now. While recent USDA Food Insecurity numbers have dropped slightly, there are still over 11 million missing meals in our service area annually. At Channel One we are looking ahead to see what we can do to help provide those missing meals. We will keep looking forward and planning until the day I can tell you - and we can celebrate the fact- that together we have ended hunger in our communities. **Because together we are feeding people and changing lives.**
