There have been many changes at Channel One over the past year, including one highly visible change. We have a new logo and a new tagline, both designed to help people understand all that we do at Channel One Regional Food Bank. Our mission remains the same, to work in partnership with others to help feed people in need. Our new logo and tagline tell our story: we are a Food Bank that last year distributed over eight million pounds of food to people struggling with hunger in southeast Minnesota and La Crosse County in Wisconsin.

We operate the Channel One Supplemental Food Shelf program that distributes food throughout Olmsted County. Our Food Shelf serves nearly 4,000 families every single month. We have a Green Garden program, where Food Shelf clients can grow their own produce to supplement their food budgets. We support Backpack programs in several communities in our service area, including Rochester Public Schools where we distribute backpacks full of food to 1,200 students on free and reduced price lunch each week. And we have a Mobile Pantry program that makes six stops throughout our service area each month, and distributed over 350,000 pounds of food directly to people in their communities last year.

Even though we might look different on the outside, our program activities remain the same – all of our activities help feed people in need. That's what's at the heart of Channel One's new tagline – Feeding People. Changing Lives. These are the same programs and activities that we have engaged in for many years, just with a fresh new look! I hope you will share my excitement for the opportunity to tell our story to you, our closest supporters, and to thousands of people who are learning about Channel One Regional Food Bank for the first time. Because together, we are feeding people and changing lives!



Channel One Regional Food Bank is the largest hunger relief organization in Southeast Minnesota. We serve people struggling with hunger, including: working families, seniors, veterans, people with disabilities, people who are homeless, disaster victims and children.





Hunger Facts

Over 85,000 people were assisted in FY 2011-2012 through Channel One hunger relief programs.

35% of households seeking food assistance have at least one employed adult.

39% of food assistance clients at Channel One are under age 18.

Over 195 agencies, programs and food shelves partner with Channel One to distribute food to the hungry.

Channel One Food Shelf is serving an average of 3,700 households per month.

Channel One Backpack Program is serving an average of 1,200 students in 20 different schools.

Channel One Green Garden Program offers 100 garden plots for clients to grow their own produce.

Channel One works with local agencies to offer emergency food assistance to residents in all of our 14-county service area.

Channel One's Mobile Food Pantry Program delivers pre-packed boxes of food monthly to six towns in three counties in Southeast Minnesota and La Crosse County, Wisconsin, that do not have ready access to a food shelf.
